



Guns and Domestic Violence.

Ridgefield's current State Representative voted against House Bill 5054, enacted in 2016 (Public Act 16-34), that requires the surrender of firearms within 24 hours of issuance of domestic violence restraining orders – claiming that the ex parte order violates due process (this is not true, as both parties are heard within a week).
